This will make a great baby quilt or a table topper.

Once you see the finished quilt, you can easily make it bigger, if you wish.

I am making it as a scrappy quilt, using, Island Batik fabrics. It can be made as a 2 colour quilt.

Fabric Requirements

Background: 1 ½ yards

Scraps: 1 – 1.5 yards (if making a 2 colour quilt, 1 yard)

CUTTING


Cut fabrics ahead of time. Label as directed

Background	18	5" x 5" squares	Step 1	
	36	4 ½" x 2 ½ " rectangles	Step 2	
	9	4 ½"" x 4 ½"" squares	Step 3	
	4	4 ½" WOF strips	border	
Colour	18	5" x 5" squares	Step 1	
	36	4 ½" x 2 ½ " rectangles	Step 2	
	5	2 ½" WOF strips	binding	

STEP 1
Gather

(18) 5" x 5" background squares

(18) 5" x 5" coloured squares



Mark a line down the diagonal centre (from one corner to the other) of either the background or the coloured squares. (Shown as the black line in the diagram / Square #1 in the picture)
With right sides together, sew 1/4" from the centre

With right sides together, sew ¼" from the centre black line (red line). Repeat on the other side of the black line (green line). (Square #2 from the back side)


Cut down the centre line. This will yeild 2 Half

Square Triangles.

Press open (Square #3)

Trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. (Square #4)

Repeat this with the rest of the squares. Yield: 36 HST (half square triangles)




STEP 2

Gather (36) 4 ½" x 2 ½" background rectangle (36) 4 ½" x 2 ½" coloured rectangle

Sew each coloured rectangle to a background rectangle along the 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " side. Press towards the dark.

Yeild: 36 squares.



STEP 3


Gather

- (9) 4 ½" x 4 1/2" Squares
- (18) Squares made from Step 2 (Coloured and Background)

Sew: The coloured side of Square from Step 2 onto each side of the Background square.

Press towards Step 2

Make 9





Step 4

Gather

(18) Squares made from Step 2 (Coloured and Background)

(36) HST from Step 1

Sew a HST onto each end of a Square from Step 2 Press towards Step 2 Make 18



Step 5

Part 1: Gather Step 3 and Step 4 units.




Assemble blocks. Press towards Step 4 blocks

Make 9.
